

Kalsøy Island

1-DAY ITINERARY

FAROE ISLANDS

08:00 – FERRY FROM KLAKSVIK TO SYÐRADALUR

Take your car along (recommended) or use the local bus connection.
Enjoy the short 20-minute crossing with views of cliffs and sea.

08:30 – DRIVE NORTH TO TRØLLANES

Pass through the famous single-lane tunnels and admire the dramatic coastline on the way.

09:00 – HIKE TO KALLUR LIGHTHOUSE

Allow about 2–2.5 hours round trip. Spend time at the lighthouse viewpoint for photos, cliff views, and puffin spotting in summer.

11:30 – EXPLORE THE VILLAGE OF TRØLLANES

Wander the tiny settlement, enjoy the calm atmosphere, and eat a packed lunch surrounded by sheep and mountains.

12:30 – DRIVE TO MIKLADALUR

Park at the village entrance or inside, depending on space. 12:45 – Coffee & cake at Café Eðge (summer only).

13:30 – VISIT THE SEAL WOMAN STATUE

Walk down the steps to the 3-meter bronze statue, learn the legend, and admire the dramatic Atlantic backdrop.

14:00 – WATERFALL & CLIFF WALK

See the Mikladalur waterfall and waddle along the cliffs for views and, if lucky, puffins.

14:45 – SCENIC STOP AT HÚSAR

Pause at the edge of the village, sit on the bench, enjoy sea and mountain views (and possibly meet some friendly cows).

15:15 – ARRIVE BACK IN SYÐRADALUR

Use the facilities, stroll through the small village, and visit the memorial stone while waiting for the ferry.

16:00 – FERRY BACK TO KLAKSVIK
