

Penguin Stone Instruction

- ✦ **Pack** the penguin stone on your adventure.
- ✦ **Choose the location** where you will leave the penguin stone.
- ✦ At the location **take at least 3 pictures** or more, feel free to even take a **video**.
 - ✦ **One** photo holding the stone with the lovely view in the back (horizontal)
 - ✦ **Second** photo of the place where the penguin stone is hidden
 - ✦ The **third** photo of the beautiful view/place around
 - ✦ **Other** photos based on your preference (see other post on the blog for inspiration)
 - ✦ Ensure that one of the photos is taken from a zoomed-out perspective to clearly show the location where the stone is placed.(you can even point there, or mark it on the photo)
- ✦ When hiding the penguin stone ensure it is not clearly visible, but really hidden.
- ✦ **Mark down the GPS coordinates** (using for example Google Maps) of the location and **the number of the stone** on the back.
 - ✦ Send the pictures with the **GPS coordinates** and the penguin stone number to **lifeguin@gmail.com**



Feel free to include a short story about why you chose this place to hide the penguin stone.
